The new look will be much nicer; and we are anticipating moving back into the offices within the next several weeks.

I want to thank each of you for your commitment to Christian education and for the funds you donated this past summer for the much-needed technology upgrade. We now have a flatscreen TV/DVD in every classroom with access to the internet. This truly has been a blessing for our teachers and each student as our teachers are utilizing and taking advantage of this upgrade.

As we have been making improvements to our facility, we have become aware of our continually failing and aging computers. Service calls are having to be made on a monthly basis to seemingly just put a “bandaid” on the problem. The computers in the entire school (offices, classrooms, computer lab) are over 10 years old and are now in need of replacement - not repair. We have recently been given the opportunity to purchase new Dell computers at a discounted price. It will take approximately 30 computers to outfit the entire school. This would include the offices, classrooms, and the student computers in the library.

Our goal is to have these new computers bought and installed as soon as possible; however, because of budget constraints, this will be difficult without the help of our school stakeholders. This is where we are asking many individuals to partner together with us to make this become a reality. Each computer (with software included) costs approximately \$350.
